11:59pm. Athletes must be entered as "unattached" if they are not members of a USATF-registered club.

LATE ENTRIES: Please note the late entry fee is \$20.00.

ATHLETE CHECK-IN: RUNNING EVENTS: 45-minutes prior to the scheduled start of each running event, competitors must

check-in at the **CLERKS TENT near the stadium entry**—after which those who have not checked-in will be scratched. 20 minutes prior to each running event, runners must return to the Clerk to pick-up their hip

number and heat assignment.

FIELD EVENTS: 45-minutes prior to the event, competitors much check-in with the Head Judge.

San Diego Mesa College is located at 7250 Mesa College Drive, approximately one and a quarter miles south of Balboa, between Convoy Street (becomes Linda Vista Road) and Genesee Avenue.

Bus Route Information

Driving on I-805 South

Take I-805 South.

Exit at the 805 Freeway at the BALBOA AVE EAST exit.

Merge onto BALBOA AVE and cross over the 805freeway.

Turn RIGHT onto CONVOY Street.

CONVOY Street becomes LINDA VISTA Road after about 1 mile.

Turn RIGHT onto MESA COLLEGE DR.

Follow Mesa College Drive for approximately one half mile onto the campus and make the first LEFT. Proceed to metered parking across from the Administration Building.

There is a large American Flag in front of the building.

Driving on I-805 North

Exit at Mesa College Drive.

At the top of the exit ramp turn left onto Mesa College Drive.

Cross Linda Vista Road, and continue on Mesa College Drive for approximately one half a mile onto the campus and make the first LEFT.

Follow Mesa College Drive to metered parking across from the Administration Building. There is a large American Flag in front of the building.

Driving on Freeway 163 South

Exit at Genessee West and continue on Genessee West to Linda Vista Road

Turn Right onto Linda Vista Road.

Continue on Linda Vista Road for approximately 1 mile to Mesa College Drive.

Turn LEFT onto MESA COLLEGE DR.

Follow Mesa College Drive for approximately one half mile onto the campus and make the first LEFT. Proceed to metered parking across from the Administration Building.

There is a large American Flag in front of the building.

Driving on Freeway 163 North

Exit on Mesa College Drive.

At the top of the freeway ramp turn Left onto Mesa College Drive.

Continue on Mesa College across Linda Vista Road. Approximately one half mile.

Follow Mesa College Drive for approximately one half mile onto the campus and make the first LEFT. Proceed to metered parking across from the Administration Building. There is a large American Flag in front of the building.

MERRILL DOUGLAS STADIUM SYNTHETIC TURF FIELD AND TRACK RULES AND REGULATIONS

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. No metal spiked athletic shoes on track or field.

Only 3/16" pyramid spikes are allowed on track.

- 2. No food or drink (except water).
- 3. No vehicles or trailers.
- 4. No alcoholic beverages or illegal substances.
- 5. No chewing gum/sunflower (or any other) seeds.
- 6. No smoking or tobacco products.
- 7. No glass bottles or glass containers.
- 8. No confetti or rice.
- 9. No weapons, fireworks, explosives or open flames.
- 10. No bikes, rollerblades, skates or skateboards.
- 11. No chairs with pointed/sharp legs.
- 12. No spikes, poles, nails or posts placed or driven into the field.
- 13. No flags or field markings driven into the field.
- 14. No pets or animals.
- 15. No golfing.
- 16. No javelin or shot putting on turf.
- 17. No permanent marking on the field.
- 18. No spectators on the field at any time.
- 19. No high pressure washing on the field.
- 20. No use of wire brushes on the field.
- 21. No activities that might damage the field
- 22. No littering. All waste is to be disposed of in designated trash receptacles.
- 23. No selling or vending of any articles.
