Some Southern California Association teams have been invited.</li> <li>The Chair noted the event, which was discussed in February conflicts with the USA Rockets Meet, and therefore has not been placed on the website or advertised.</li> <li>Presently 79 athletes from Mexico are scheduled to participate and the number is expected to grow.</li> <li>Each participant will get a tee shirt and other items.</li> <li>CALIFORNIA STATE GAMES – The Chair reported attendance may suffer this year due to a meet held in the Southern California Association (SCA) on the same weekend. Association Junior Olympic Championships	<ul> <li>A discussion was held about the length of the days for the Association Championships. In past years, the meet was a three (3) day meet with certain events contested for the Intermediate and Young Division on the first day (Friday). However, due to several high school graduations and graduation related events it has created conflicts. The number of athletes that compete is not excessively high as to create a burden on the other two days.</li> <li>The general consensus was to hold the meet over a two (2) day period (Saturday and Sunday). The Chair noted the possible impact would likely be a longer day on Sunday.</li> <li>The Chair reported Junior Olympic Forms will soon be made available.</li> <li>The Chair requested teams to begin to ensure all birthdates are verified.</li> <li>The Chair indicated officials and volunteers will be needed for the meet. The past couple of meets have relied heavily on 2-3 teams for volunteers. Greater participation from all member teams is requested.</li> <li>The site is still to be confirmed.</li> </ul>
