	 International Friendship Games (IFG). The IFG consists of the track and field, basketball, soccer, baseball, softball, and the battle of the bands. Track and field had the largest group of participants. 200 track athletes from Mexico are expected to participate. Mexican athletes will cross at the Otay Mesa Border Crossing beginning at 6AM and transported to Mater Dei High School, the site of the event. Athletes will be permitted to entry the United States on a one day visa. Opening Ceremonies will be held at 10AM. The ceremonies are expected to last at least 30 minutes. All athletes from the sports are asked to participate. There was much discussion about the interruption of the meet which was slated to start at 8:00AM. The Committee asked the Councilman's representatives to share with the event organizer that full participation in this meet is jeopardized due to the interruption. An earlier time for the opening ceremony was discussed. Mr. Renteria indicated that he would discuss the Committee's concerns, but felt that it would be difficult at this point to adjust the opening ceremony. The Committee advised the Councilman's representatives that we would discuss further and advise as to the start time. After the representatives left the Committee discussed the meet start time and events. The meet will begin at 10:30AM. The 3000 meters will be run at the end of the meet. The meet schedule will be adjusted similar to the 'N Step Track Meet. The Councilman's representatives stated participants will receive a tee shirt, brochure, wristband for lunch. Officials, coaches and volunteers working the meet will serve eaver yto get the names of the Mexican athletes with the next day. The Chair and Coach Tate will serve as co-meet directors for this meet. Volunteers were solicited from teams participanting as well as teams that
